2022 PIER PARK Pirates of the High Seas Information Cover Sheet

Dear Pirate Festival Parade Participants:

The 2022 Panama City Beach Pirates of the High Seas Parade is scheduled for Saturday October 8th, 2022 and will start at 4:30pm. Staging will take place along Stingray Drive behind Target & JC Penny in Pier Park and the entrance to the staging area will be in the same place as last year behind Target just off Powell Adams Road. The route will also be the same as last year. All units are encouraged to be in the staging area between 10am and 2:30pm. Any entry arriving after 2:30pm will be denied entry into the parade.

Application deadline: Tuesday October 4th, 2022 – All paperwork must be in the hands of the parade director by this date. No applications will be accepted after October 4th, 2022.

Please review the attached rules and regulations that govern the parade. The parade marshals and police department will strictly enforce these regulations, and anyone violating them will be escorted out of the parade.

The following is a list of the documents/procedures required for participation in either parade:

- ____ Read the Parade Rules and share them with other group participants.
- ____ Fill out and return the parade application.
- ____ Fill out and sign the Hold Harmless Agreement.
- ____ Verify that you have one-wheel walker per axle on BOTH sides of your floats (one per side for automobiles). Wheel Walkers are an absolute requirement for child safety.
- ____ Prepare and return an electronic copy of a brief description of your entry as you would like it to be read by media during the TV broadcast of the parade.
- ____ Provide proof of liability insurance for the driver and vehicle towing your parade floats.
- ____ Remit your entry fee payment payable to "Mardi Gras At The Beach"

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2022 Pirates of the High Seas Rules

- ___ Entries must display pirate themes and costumes that are wholesome and appropriate for an audience of children, adults and seniors.
- ___ Only organizations that have completed the Parade Entry Application, Release, Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement will be allowed into the parade.
- ___ Entries must provide Mardi Gras "throws" for the spectators. Promotional throws are allowed provided they do not include unpackaged paper products. All throws must be approved by the Pirates of the High Seas Parade Director or Festival Chairman prior to the parade.
- ___ There shall be no alcoholic beverages consumed by the participants during the parade.
- ___ Mardi Gras At The Beach, Inc. assumes no responsibility for personal property.
- ___ All entries and participants must arrive at staging areas by 3:00pm prior to the parade.
- ___ Each float must have a spotter (wheel walker) on each side of all axles.
- ___ Each parade entrant MUST send a minimum of one representative to a safety briefing that will be held at 3:30pm
- ___ This is a family friendly event. Any music played must have "clean" lyrics. Profanity or improper insinuations will cause the participant to be pulled from the parade.

FLOAT DEFINITION

- ___ A float is defined as a decorated, wheel object either pulled or self-propelled. A float must be no taller than thirteen feet and decorated in keeping with the theme and spirit of the Pirates of the High Seas Festival.
- ___ I/We the undersigned hereby covenant and assume all risks and hazards to my/our participation in the Pirates of the High Seas Parade. I/We do hereby waive, release, absolve, indemnify and agree to hold harmless Mardi Gras at the Beach, the Krewe of Dominique Youx, and the KODY Foundation, Inc., their agents, organizers, sponsors, officers, and volunteers from any and all liability while participating in the Pirates of the High Seas Parade.

Do you need help with Beads?

Where do I buy them? How many should I get?

What kind? What about shipping?

What do they cost?

If you have a good source for beads and other throws, that's great! However, if you don't want to hassle with rounding up beads, getting them shipped, storing them, and that kind of thing...we can help.

The beads we will have available are a mix of styles, from 33" to 60" long, in a quantity of 36 dozen per case. Our Krewe members will throw 1 – 2 cases in our parade, but some folks will throw only a few dozen...depends on how you pace yourself.

If you would like for us to get your beads for you...we will. The catch is that you will need to send in your paid order with your parade registration. Just fill in what you want on the registration form. Obviously, we don't have an unlimited number, so it's first ordered, first served. Hopefully, we will have enough to go around and make everyone happy, and no matter what, we'll let you know if we run out WAY ahead of time.

The cost to you is \$65 per case, including tax. Your beads will be set aside specifically for you and will be waiting for you when you check in for the parade.
